- The Riso Screen system simplifies the silk-screening process.
- This process is quick, fun and simple and used by both absolute beginners and professionals.
- The Riso system uses a thermal process to instantly turn your black and white artwork into an instant silkscreen with your artwork on it!
- This process has revolutionised the way we do silk-screens!
- You can either bring in a USB with your PDF file on it into Jacksons Perth store or you can email us an attached PDF of your artwork to process (email to perth@jacksons.com.au with your name & contact number).

Digital RISO Print

The digital service will print grey scale and will pick up more detail in the artwork. Please supply a **PDF format file only** (we cannot print from .jpg, .tiff, .bmp etc).

A3 297 x 410mm \$50 nett Code: 126418

IMAGE SETTINGS:

- Please take care to ensure the page dimensions of your image are set to the sizes listed above. This can be done in the page set up function in the editing program you use.
- If you're transforming a hand drawn image into a riso screen, please increase the contrast of the image in a program such as Photoshop to ensure a crisp print out as the machine prints greyscale and will easily detect faint smudges or lines.
- The provided image needs to be in PDF format.
- **No re-sizing of images** – how the image is saved is how the image will print.
- You must allow space around the outside for ink run-off and for your squeegees start/finish position.
- Minimum Resolution should be 300dpi and a maximum of 600dpi

Disclaimer

- The sizing of your image is your responsibility. We do not have the ability to modify the size of your image and as a result the file shall be printed according to the dimensions of the sent image.
- If the dimensions of the sent file are larger than the dimensions listed above e.g. 211 x 299 mm for an A4 sized image, then the image will not print.
- Your image should be approximately one third of the screen size i.e. an A5 design on an A4 frame This is to afford space around the outside for ink run-off/frame mounting.
